**Call to Order**

**Purpose of the Work Session**

To discuss the radium removal project.

**Discussion**

The city engineer, Chuck Schwartz, updated the council on the progress of the Water Treatment project to address the radium in the water supply.

Some points to note:

1. Is blending a solution, is there a risk of radium showing up?
2. Is the city hall site an appropriate site for long-term treatment?
3. What future mandates may occur, such as addressing magnesium?
4. Funding will be solicited based upon the most expensive option and can be adjusted once more is known about the final project.
5. Topography and wetland study need to be done.
6. Need to determine if building and well can ultimately be located on city hall site. If site cannot be utilized then doesn't make sense to have test well at the location.
7. Do we need permanent or temporary construction easements?
8. Geotechnical evaluations: review soil; how will it support the structure. What site improvements need to be done, mitigating wetland?

Brett Repulske of Rural Development presented information regarding funding for the project; he described the ability of the Stacy to receive some grant funds for the project.
