*The Chisago County Sheriff's Office mission is to build strong community partnerships so that we can provide effective and efficient law enforcement services to our community.*



A call for service (CFS) is generated for nearly anything that a deputy does while on duty. This can include a traffic stop, residential security check, lost child or major criminal event just to name a few. Criminal and non-criminal incidents are documented equally.



## —HIGHLIGHTS—

In March, Dep. Scott Swanson responded to a Chisago Lake Township residence where a 51 yr old man was not breathing. Dep. Swanson took over CPR and performed until EMT's arrived. He then drove the ambulance while the EMT's tried to revive the man.

Also in March, Sgt. Shane Carroll assisted EMT's for a Shafer resident who had suffered a heart attack.

In October, a Rush City High School student collapsed outside during gym class. Sgt. Jason Foster and school staff applied AED shocks. The student survived and has made a full recovery.



Chisago County Citizen's Academy had 16 participants. The Citizen's Academy is a way for the community to see "life behind the badge." The next Citizen's Academy will be in September of 2016. Look at Facebook and local newspapers for registration.

# LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER



The new Chisago County Jail would be located on land already owned by the county on Per Road in Center City and it would have 125 beds. The estimated cost is approximately \$23 million. The county is pursuing about \$12 million in bonding money through the state and should know if it will be receiving those dollars when the Legislature convenes its regular session in May. Members of the Bonding Committee took a tour of our facility on December 1, 2015. Chisago County has also hired a lobbyist to help in our request to the Legislature.

The construction documents are expected to be sent out to bid in mid to late March. If the Board of Commissioners vote to accept the bids, then construction of the facility could be in the spring of 2016.
