

City of Stacy Trash/Recycling Collection Needs

Cart/dumpster sizes are what we have currently, but we are open to suggestions!

City Hall (30955 Forest Blvd.)

- 1 96-gallon trash cart to be picked up weekly
- 1 64-gallon recycling cart to be picked up bi-weekly

Public Works (5660 Stacy Trail)

- 2 96-gallon trash carts to be picked up weekly

Twins Field/Sunrise Park (30351-30433 Fir Trail)-Allen asked if we could get a trash can for this ballfield. Currently he takes the trash barrels from there and empties them into one of the PW cans, but it is messy and results in having to clean the truck more often.

- 1 96-gallon trash cart to be picked up weekly

These 2 locations need to be separated on the invoice, but can be on the same one.

Liquor locations need to be invoiced separately from city locations, and each other.

Stacy Sports Grill (6007 Stacy Trail)

- 1 3-yard Trash Dumpster to be picked up two time a week, three times weekly as requested
- 1 2-yard Recycling Dumpster to be picked up two times a week, three times weekly as requested

*The corral for the dumpsters is pretty small, but would like to go a larger recycling dumpster if space would allow.

Stacy Wine & Spirits (30692 Fenway Ave)

- 1 96-gallon trash cart to be picked up weekly
- 1 96-gallon recycling cart to be picked up bi-weekly
- 1 6-yard cardboard/recycling dumpster

Currently Paying through Waste Management-See above list for # of containers and type

The clerk's department ended up contacting WM because the billing statements for the City Hall and Maintenance Building did not make sense. The City Hall statement reflected biweekly pickup for both trash and recycling, and indicated that there were 3 trash carts and 1 recycling, where we have 1 trash and 1 recycling. The price on this was substantially lower than the Public Works statement, which was accurate at 2 trash carts, biweekly as well. Allen advised that they have been picking up trash weekly, but that is not what WM has in their system. Subsequently, WM sent new quotes on these two locations and are encouraging that we enter into a 3-year contract with them

based on these prices. The second meeting attachment under this line item provides the updated quotes for City Hall and the Maintenance Building.
