Background:

The Maintenance Committee recently discussed the change in our city limits and the need for new signs for the city. It was proposed that we leave the one south of the City on Forest Blvd. where it is, replace the one north of the City on Forest Blvd. and move it to the new border, and place new ones on the east and west ends of County Road 19/Stacy Trail, and another on the west end of County Road 17/Athens Trail. Chisago County is willing to place the posts and install a standard green city sign with population numbers free of charge. The City will need to provide the population number to the County. The City is welcome to order custom signs, and the County will still install the posts free of charge, but the City will have to pay for the sign and our Maintenance Department will need to install it after the post is in.

Action Requested:

Determine what type of signs the Council would like installed at the borders of the newly combined city. If the standard green city sign is selected, we need to provide our population number to the County.
