**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 30
OF THE CITY CODE §30.07**

The City Council of the City of Stacy ordains that Chapter 30, Section 30.07 is amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the ~~strikethrough~~ language as follows:

SECTION 3. Chapter 30, §30.07 (D)

§ 30.07 COMMITTEES.

(A) Committees. The Council may create such committees, standing or special, as it deems necessary. The Mayor shall appoint the members and the committee shall appoint the Chairperson of any committee created by the Council.

(B) Membership. The Council shall establish the number of Council members who shall serve on each committee at the time of the committee's creation. Each committee member shall serve as appointed and may be removed from the committee by a majority of the members of the Council without cause. If a committee member is absent for 3 or more committee meetings within the calendar year without a valid excuse by the committee Chair, the absent committee member shall be removed by the Council. If the committee does not provide otherwise, committee meetings shall be held at the call of the Chairperson.

(C) Referral and reports. Any matter brought before the Council for consideration may be referred by the presiding officer to the appropriate committee or to a special committee appointed by him or her for a written report and recommendation before it is considered by the Council as a whole. Each committee shall act promptly and faithfully on any matter referred to it.

(D) Definition of Non-Resident City Property Taxpayer. Non-Resident City Property Taxpayers must have a personal financial interest in which taxes are paid. Examples include sole proprietorships, or corporations in which financial gain or loss of a company is reflected on their personal tax return. W2 or 1099 office holders of companies or corporations are not included as a Non-Resident Taxpayer. Any person who pays property taxes to the City of Stacy but does not have a residence within the city limits.
