

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2024-5-1

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 51
OF THE CITY CODE §51.22**

The City Council of the City of Stacy ordains that Chapter 51, Section 51.22 is amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the ~~striketthrough~~ language as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 51, Section 51.22

§ 51.22 MAINTENANCE.

The city shall maintain and repair at its expense any meter that has become unserviceable through ordinary wear and tear and shall replace it if necessary. Any utility customer refusing repair or replacement of their water meter shall pay a fine set forth in the city fee schedule. After three consecutive billing cycles from the date of refusal, the account will be subject to utility shut off procedures. Where repair or replacement is made necessary by act or neglect of the owner or occupant of the premises it serves, any city expense caused thereby shall be a charge against and collected from the water consumer, and water service may be discontinued until the cause is corrected and the amount charged is paid. The fine for tampering with a meter is set forth in the city fee schedule.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
