Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Utecht at 7:00pm.

Purpose of the Special Meeting

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the Stacy Sports Grill.

No Trespass

Mayor Utecht said that an employee at the bar was harassed by a group of patrons; based on the information he received he feels that there is enough merit to have three individuals placed on no trespass status at the Stacy Sports Grill.

Motion by Utecht that Kris LaCasse, Tim LaCasse, and Matt Swanson be placed on a no trespass list if they enter the Sports Grill again. Second by Ness. Members Utecht, Ness, Lucia, and Olivolo voted yes. Member LaMotte voted no. Mayor Utecht declared the motion carried.

Kris LaCasse started to speak; the city attorney asked that she cease speaking as the city needs to follow the open meeting law.

The council approved the no trespass form for use at the Sports Grill; simply if an employee asks a patron to leave and they don't then the sheriff's office is called to issue the citation.



Interim Manager

Mayor Utecht spoke with Rod Olson and he is willing to help out. The interim staffing at the Sports Grill will be determined after the meeting with the employees.

Meeting with the Employees
