RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CHISAGO LAKES JOINT SEWAGE TREATMENT  
COMMISSION LOAN APPLICATION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Stacy is a member of the Chisago Lakes Joint Sewage Treatment Commission, which is applying to the Minnesota Public Facilities Authority for a loan from the Clean Water Revolving Fund for the Corridor Lift Station Improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the loan amount is estimated at \$850,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission's financial consultant, Baker Tilly, has presented an analysis of funding scenarios for consideration; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has considered the alternatives for financing the proposed improvements and determined that the Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund, administered by the Public Finance Authority (PFA), is the most economical means of the funding the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has the legal authority to apply for the loan and the financial, technical, and managerial capacity to repay the loan and ensure proper construction, operation, and maintenance of the project for its design life;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that:

1. The City of Stacy supports the loan application to the Minnesota Public Facilities Authority from the Clean Water Revolving Fund for the Corridor Lift Station Improvements.
2. The City of Stacy hereby expresses its official intent to make payments to the Chisago Lakes Joint Sewage Treatment Commission in accordance with the Joint Powers Agreement.
