**Purpose of the Special Meeting**

The purpose of the Special Meeting is to discuss the County Highway 30 (CSAH 30) project.

**Discussion**

The CSAH 30 project was discussed after the county hosted an open house this evening; there were a couple of property owners who attended. Their main concern was regarding storm water run-off that occurs across 311<sup>th</sup> and into their back yards (they front Forest Boulevard between 311<sup>th</sup> and Stacy Trail). Joe Triplett, the County Engineer said they would review stormwater run-off capacity on Forest Boulevard.

The council asked if the sidewalks would increase property taxes, this is a question for the County Assessor. Who maintains the sidewalks? Mr. Triplett said they construct the sidewalks and the city is responsible to maintain them long-term.

It was decided that a six-foot sidewalk would be sufficient for the project and be consistent with the rest of the city.

Mr. Triplett said that the county will prepare the project specifications taking into account public comment received, review with the city engineer, and the council will be able to provide further input in the future.
