Request: How do I go about getting an item on the next (October) City Council meeting agenda? I am the Treasurer and Snowmobile Trail Administrator for Kiwi Snowmobile ATV Club. I would like to propose a trail re-route with in the city. Old trail used to cross what is now All Mac just to the East of the freeway overpass. We would like to discuss options for a re-route that will help to eliminate riders from using the county road and keep them out of home owners yards to get access to city as well as to the Sunrise trail.

One option would be to route traffic in the ditch - right of way on the South side of the county road just East of the overpass to Fenway and cross the county road to the old fire department property and back to Sherman Oaks Rd where the trail is routed currently.
