### From the Council:

Finally, Spring is here!

After much hard work, in October the City Council passed an overhaul of our sign ordinance. You can view the new ordinance online or can obtain a copy by contacting the City Clerk.

In December, the Council also approved the budget for this year. The levy is set at \$428,991. This is a \$5,021 increase. The Council tries to keep the levy down as to not increase taxes. Liquor Operations is set to transfer \$120,000 to the city this year:

- \$90,000 goes towards reducing property taxes
- \$30,000 is used to pay a portion of the water bond payment instead of placing this amount on the property taxes

We had our Financial Advisor review both our sewer and water funds. It was determined that an increase occur in the Water Fund in the amount of 3.5%; this will ensure the city has adequate funds to continue maintenance of the system and meet its bond obligations.

We hired John Wicklander as the new Stacy Sports Grill manager in March. Stop by and say hi to him.

We are also currently reviewing our city code extensively; watch our website and the bulletin board outside city hall for meeting notices.; we are also now using the Chisago County Press as our legal newspaper, any public notices will be published there.
